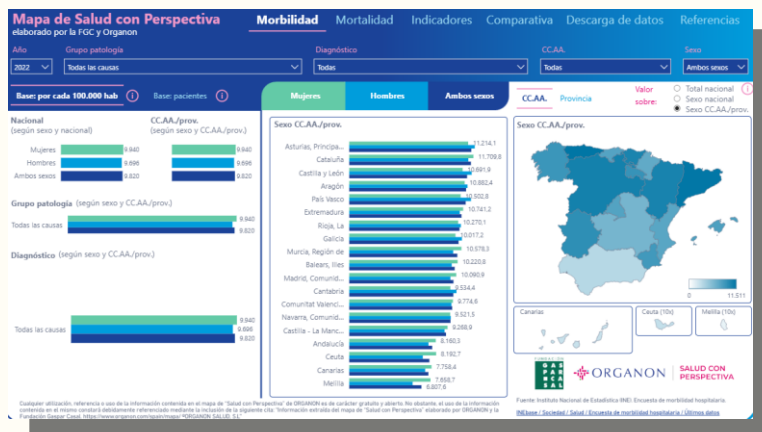

Create a European Women's Health Task Force

Goal: Validate 15–20 priority pathologies to scale the Health Map across the EU.

Members: MEPs, public health experts, HCPs, KOLs, patients, and civil society.

Mission: Strengthen EU health systems through good governance, transparency, and real-time access to critical data.
